Hong Kong, July 3, 2025 — Principal Financial Group® today announced the successful completion of its 145,000-hour global volunteerism goal, a milestone set in July of 2024 to celebrate the company's 145th anniversary and enduring commitment to building strong communities. One year later, that collective effort has resulted in 157,657 volunteer hours served to support more than 4,100 nonprofits and community organizations across the globe — a 50% increase in volunteer hours completed by Principal® employees as compared to the prior year.

As part of this global effort, employees across the Asia Pacific (APAC) and the Middle East contributed more than 7,800 volunteer hours to support a wide range of nonprofits and community organizations, demonstrating a deep commitment to service. Teams across APAC and the Middle East brought Principal® values to life through a wide range of community initiatives.

In Thailand, employees helped repaired the surrounding of Beaumont Ruam Pattana School, a training school for underprivileged children, while Hong Kong teams promoted environmentally conscious products at eco-bazaars. In Singapore, volunteers supported the elderly through care programs, and Indonesian employees shared creativity with youth communities. In Malaysia, employees spent time with the children of National Autism Society of Malaysia, while Australian volunteers cooked meals using rescued ingredients. Japanese employees crafted handmade blankets for children in hospitals, and UAE teams facilitated clothing donation and resale initiatives. These efforts reflect the continued commitment of Principal to fostering inclusive, community-driven change throughout the Asia Pacific and Middle East region.
